


The CapCity Alphas

Beta Gamma Lambda (ΒΓΛ) was chartered May 4, 1935 in Richmond, Virginia with approximately thirty-two Charter Brothers that include six (6) officers and twenty-six (26) members in that beginning year. Beta Gamma Lambda grew out of Gamma Chapter (the Third, Oldest House of Alpha) at Virginia Union University.

Thomas W. Henderson was also a Past President of Virginia Union University and the Henderson Center was named after him in his honor. Then, as is the case now, they were college educated men from a diverse economic status, disciplines, geographical regions, and political persuasions. We are educators, administrators, lawyers, judges, social scientists, scientists, engineers, politicians, clergymen, bankers, etc.

During that period in the early 1930's, Brother Thomas W. Henderson was Eastern Region Vice-President. Brother



In the 1980s, B $\Gamma\Lambda$ was extremely blessed to have various Brothers within VACAPAF (Virginia Association of Chapters of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Incorporated) to be Presidents and District VII Directors of VACAPAF namely Brothers C.E. Pennington and Dr. George H. Johnson, Jr., respectively. Both had served $B\Gamma\Lambda$ and VACAPAF extremely well and are still watching over us in spirit from Omega Chapter.

As far as the National Pan-Hellenic Council of Metropolitan Richmond (NPHCMR), BΓΛ was blessed to have two NPHCMR Presidents in their ranks. Brother James E. Cole was the first Brother from $B\Gamma\Lambda$ to serve as NPHCMR President from 1970-1971, and thirty-eight years later Brother Tony T. Moss served as the second Brother from B $\Gamma\Lambda$ to serve as NPHCMR President from 2007-2009.

Advocating for our Communities

There are many past and present brothers in $B\Gamma\Lambda$ that have distinguished themselves, and hence forged Milestones that laid the groundwork to advance our committees and nation. Over several decades, $B\Gamma\Lambda$ has sponsored the development of many socially conscious endeavors including Annual Student Scholarships, youth educational/leadership programs, A Hopeless People Is A Voteless People/Voter Registration Drives, Project Alpha, Mentoring programs, "Go-to-High School, Go-to-College", Young Achievers Program, Brothers Keepers Program, Social events, and various community projects.

2022 - 2023 LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT CIVILIZATION INSTITUTE (LDI)

Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Incorporated-Beta Gamma Lambda Chapter and the Beta Gamma Lambda Education Foundation (formerly Beta Gamma Lambda Scholarship Foundation) have sponsored the Beta Gamma Lambda Leadership Development Citizenship Institute. The Institute invites selected High School Senior Men from the Richmond Public School System (and surrounding areas) to participate in a series of workshops designed to develop responsible school and community citizens.

The Institute focuses on assisting the young men in identifying and developing their leadership skills, in learning how to conduct an effective meeting, being able to use Parliamentary Procedures/Parliamentary Authority in finding ways to resolve conflict/Conflict Resolution, exploring mental health issues and learning of lesser known contributors to Black History. Various Representatives explain the College Application Process, the Financial Aid Process, and Investments/Financial Securities to our High School Seniors. The young men also participates in Project Alpha (our National Partner Program with the March of Dimes March for Babies). The participant also have the opportunity to develop bonds with our Mentors and with each other.

The Richmond, VA Young Achievers program under the leadership of Dr. Jacquelyn S. Joyner was initiated in September 2007. The program was implemented by Commonwealth (VA) Chapter of The Links, Incorporated and Beta Gamma Lambda Chapter of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Incorporated. It is modeled after a similar program developed in 1998 by the Metro-Manhattan (NY) Chapter of the Links, Incorporated and the Alpha Gamma Lambda Chapter of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Incorporated. The goal of the program is to address the needs of primarily African-American males, to reverse the trends of low employment, high school dropout rates, and lack of opportunities. Additionally, the program will help participants to become productive, contributing citizens, now and in years to come. The ultimate aim of the program is to help participants make positive transitions from high school, to college and beyond.

The Young Achievers program is designed to reach young men from a variety of high schools.

The program coincides with the school calendar year (September to June). Sessions are held twice monthly, on designated Saturdays. With the exception of field trips, all sessions are held on the campus of Virginia Union University or virtually. Sessions are focused on education, culture, social and physical "hands-on" engaging activities and community service.

STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Art and Mathematics), activities are provided under the education component.

Cultural, physical, social and career activities are focused on attendance at cultural events. Social and soft skills developmental activities and physical activities are designed to keep the body healthy.

Students who fully participate in and complete the program are eligible for awards and prizes.



Reba Hollingsworth is a 4-time Emmy award winning TV News journalist. In her 25-plus year career in the television news industry, Reba has covered stories from the local courthouse to the White House. Reba's long TV career has led her down the path of entrepreneurship. She's the creator of the AHA Wrap and TRI V3RSA bag. Two stylish products with the purpose of making the lives of people easier. Reba can also add coauthor to her impressive career. In the book, 'Lipstick and Legacies', Reba details her journey as a news anchor and entrepreneur while enduring life's ups and downs.

Reba was born and raised in Texas. She graduated with a degree in broadcast journalism from Southwest Texas State University (currently known as Texas State

University) in San Marcos. Reba began her TV news career in the small Texas town of Victoria at KAVU-TV. Nine months later, Reba became weekend anchor at KTXS-TV in Abilene and was quickly promoted to main anchor. Five years later, Reba accepted a morning reporter position at WTVR-TV in Richmond, Virginia. Again, she was promoted quickly to morning anchor. After five years in Richmond, Reba became a freelance reporter in the DC area working for FOX 5 in DC, WBAL in Baltimore, Hearst DC bureau, and CNN Newsource.

In 2009, Reba returned to the highly rated morning show at WTVR-TV and received four regional Emmy awards for the morning newscasts. She's also received distinguished awards for her breast cancer awareness stories. Reba brought her skills and knowledge to the classroom as an adjunct professor teaching broadcast writing at Virginia Commonwealth University. Beyond her TV job, Reba is deeply invested and involved in the community she serves.

Reba stepped out on faith and pursued her entrepreneurial dreams. In 2018, she created the AHA Wrap for television news women. The stylish leg wrap holds the wireless microphone for women wearing a dress. The AHA Wrap is sold across the nation from the website and Amazon. Three years later, Reba channeled TV women again by creating the TRI V3RSA bag. However, the convertible bag goes beyond women in TV. It's the 3-in1 bag for your life.

Reba stays busy as a journalist and entrepreneur, but the center of her world is her daughter, Jillian. Reba is a member of The Metropolitan Business League, National Association of Black Journalists and Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Incorporated.


